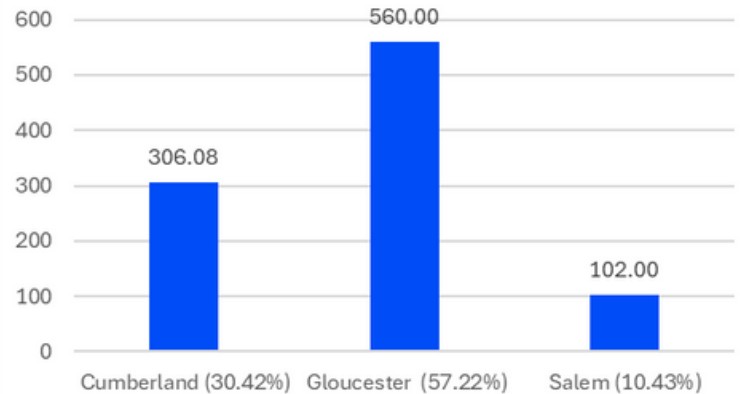

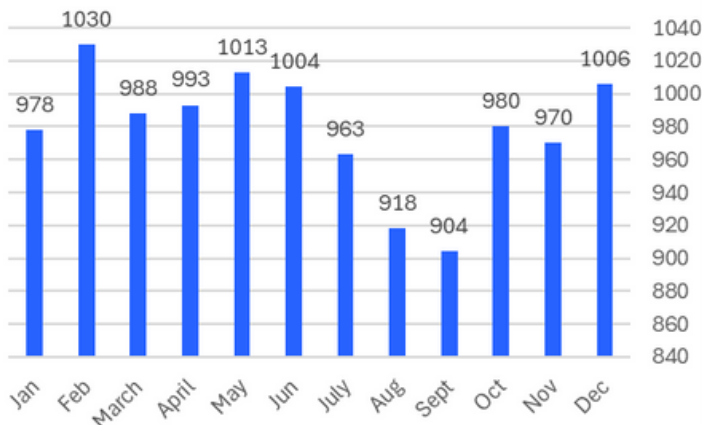
Total Youth Served to date (Calendar Year)



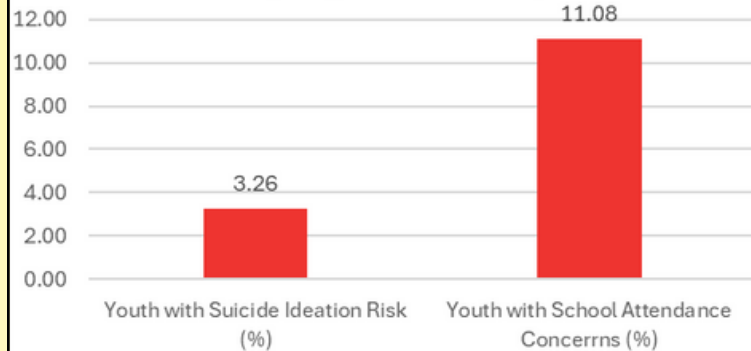
Average Monthly Number of Youth Served by County for 2024 (Average Total for Agency 979)



Total Youth Served by Month

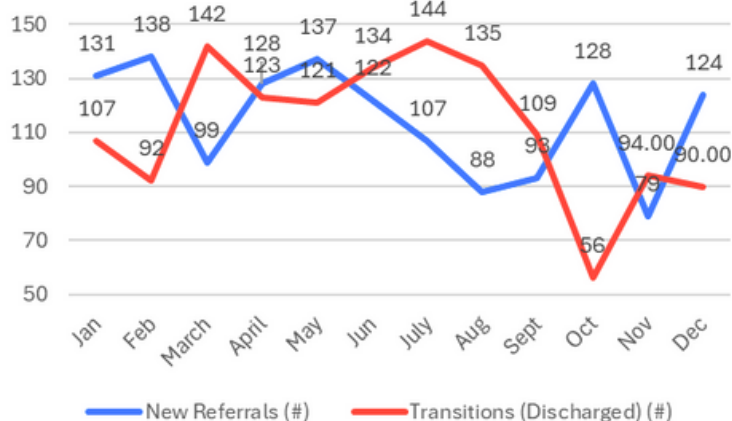


Suicidal Ideation & School Attendance Issues Identified (of Avg. 979 Youth Served)

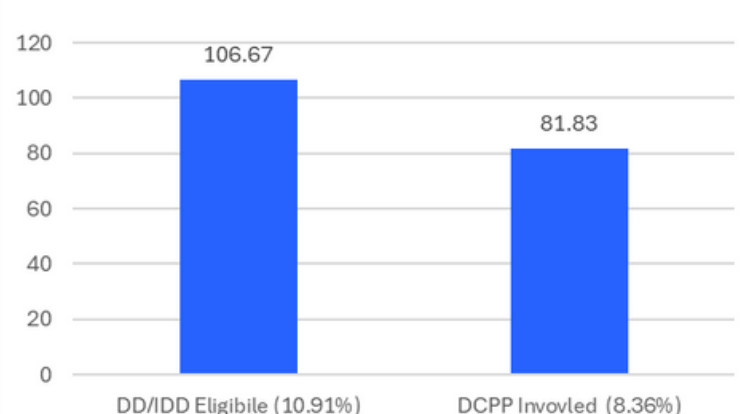

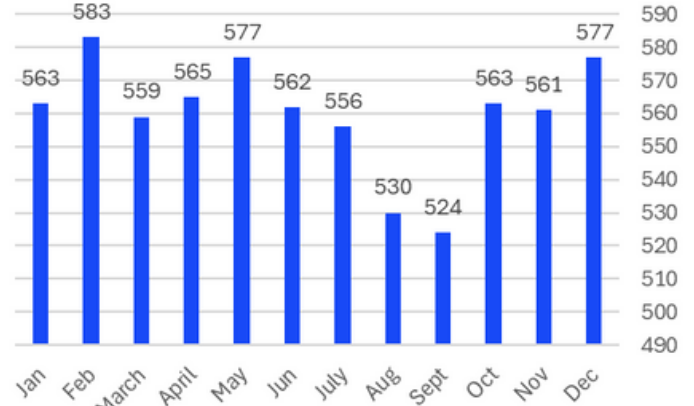

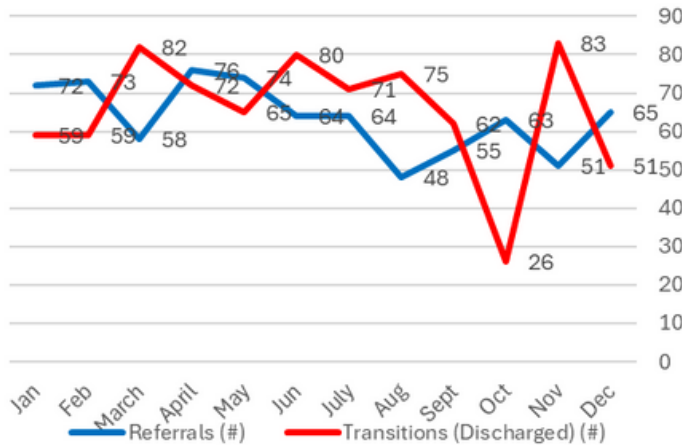
Gloucester County Ethnicity Average (Percentage)



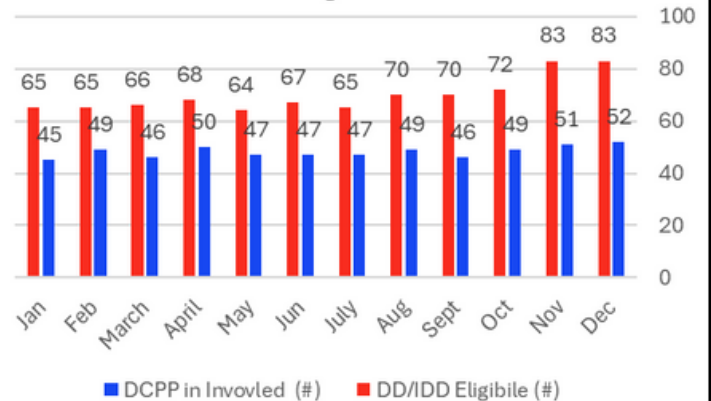
Gloucester County Number of Youth Served



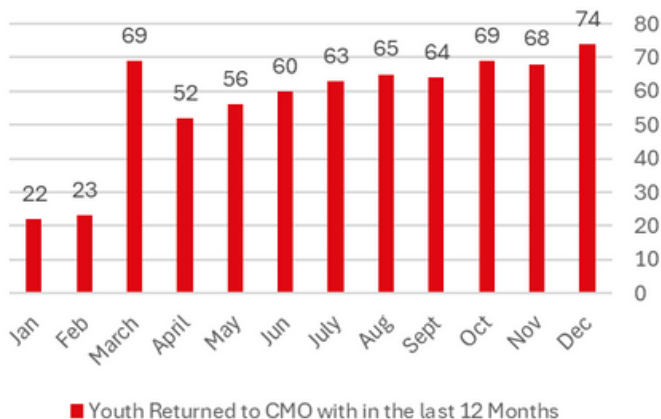
Gloucester County Referrals and Transitions



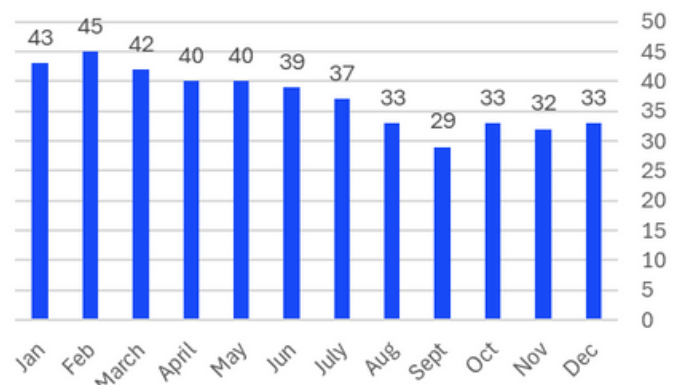
Gloucester County DDPP Involved (at time of referral) and DD Eligible Youth

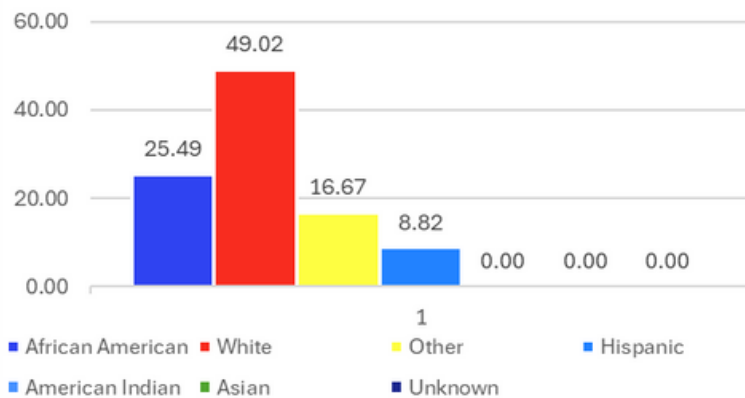

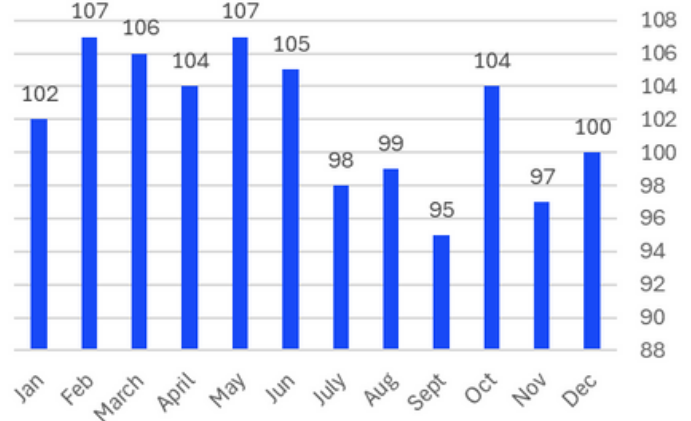

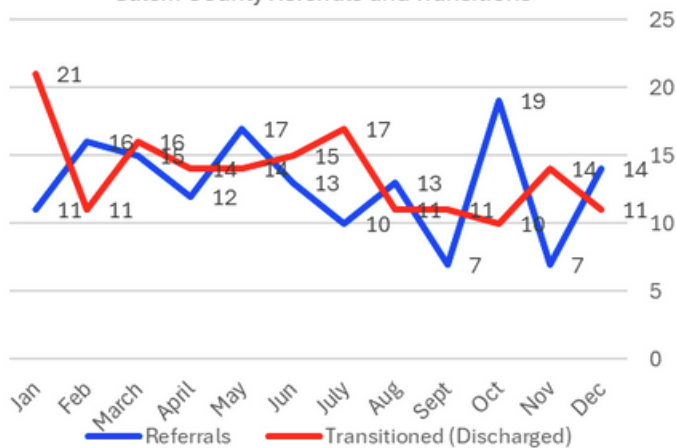
Salem County Ethnicity Average (Percentage)



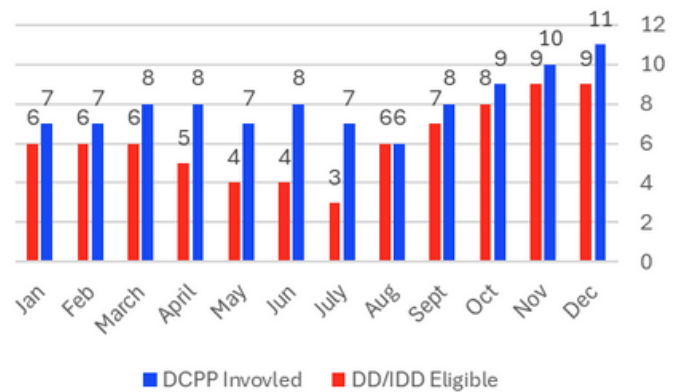
Salem County Number of Youth Served



Salem County Referrals and Transitions



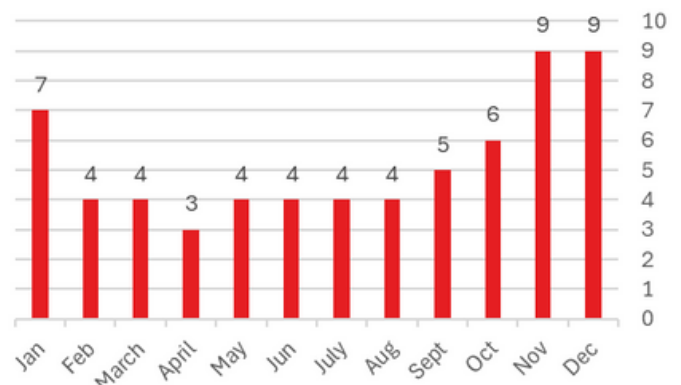
Salem County DDPP Involved (at time of referral) and DD Eligible Youth
